The TDA is worth 10 points. This is the Grading Rubric:

- **Grammar = 4 points**
 - any Capitalization error is - 1/2 point
 - any Punctuation error is - 1/2 point
 - lack of the use of Complete Sentences is -1 point
 - lack of an introduction sentence is -1 point
 - lack of a conclusion sentence is -1 point
- **Content = 6 points**
 - Temperature: 2 sentences, 1 point each

- 1 quote sentence - sentence leader added to the quote
- 1 supporting sentence – connection/reflection to the quote
- Light: 2 sentences, 1 point each
 - 1 quote sentence - sentence leader added to the quote
 - 1 supporting sentence – connection/reflection to the quote
- Graph: 2 sentences, 1 point each
 - 1 quote sentence - sentence leader added to the quote
 - 1 supporting sentence – connection/reflection to the quote
